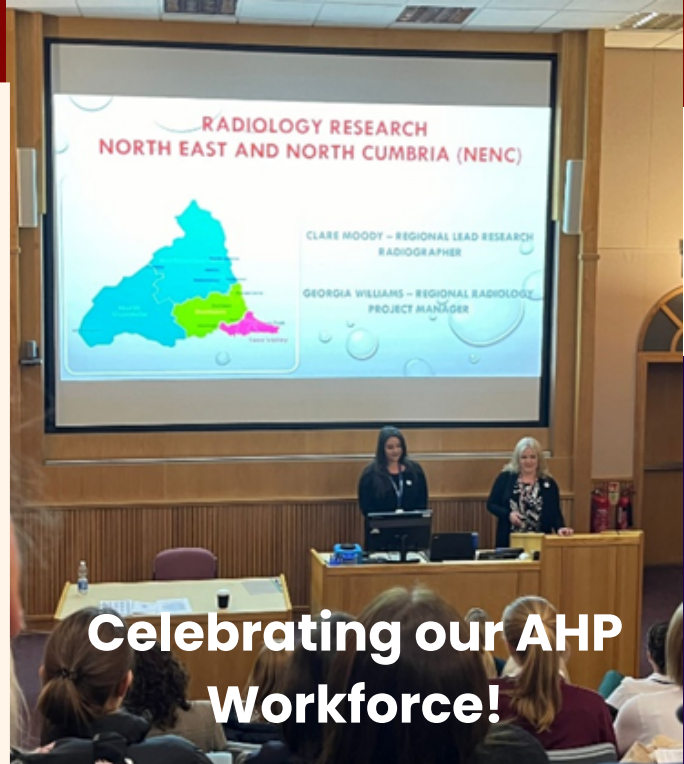
Staff Spotlight Story - Gemma Walsh

MRI Radiographer/PhD researcher, Gateshead Health NHS FT



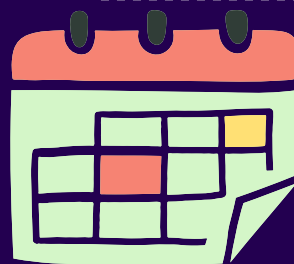
Gemma Walsh works as a MRI Radiographer at Gateshead Health NHS Foundation Trust, and has also just commenced her PhD studies funded by a College of Radiographers Industry Partnerships Scheme (CORIPS) Research Grant, led by the research team at City St George's, University of London.

Gemma recently travelled to Pisa for the EuSoMII annual conference to present her PhD project titled (pictured above), 'R-AI-diographers: a European survey to explore perceived impact of AI on professional identity, careers, and roles of radiographers'. The project won the European Congress of Radiology (ECR) 2024 Best Radiographer Abstract Award. Well done, Gemma!
